**Open Riding Rules**

*As a service to the equine community, Equine Veterinary Hospital of Northern Indiana offers open riding in our 65' x 120' indoor and 165' x 325' outdoor (weather permitting) riding arenas.*

1. To protect all of the horses that use our facility, all horses are required to have a **current negative Coggins** (within the past 12 months) and be vaccinated for **rhino/flu** within the past 12 months.
  - a. Copies of the Coggins results and proof of vaccination must be left in the payment box along with current riding waivers.
    - i. Rhino (Equine Herpes Virus) and Influenza are contagious diseases that can be transmitted from horse to horse through the environment.
    - ii. Our area of Northern Indiana has had a recent positive Coggins!
2. Riding Waivers are located by the entry door by the arena. All riders are required to have a **current riding waiver** (within the past 12 months) on file before using the facilities. There are **sign-in sheets at every entrance to our barn**, and all riders are required to sign in prior to using the arena and sign out before leaving the facility.
  - a. Copies of the waiver must be left in the secure payment box along with arena fees and other required paperwork.
  - b. Sign in/out is required for anyone entering the EVH barn. This is a liability issue, and we must know who is in the barn at all times.
3. Rides are \$10/horse/day or a monthly package (\$100/rider/month for unlimited rides) may be purchased for unlimited rides.
  - a. Payment is required before bringing horses into the barn. There is a secure payment box available for riding fees.

**Our facility is available to groups interested in hosting clinics or shows, local equestrian clubs, 4-H groups and school groups.**

## **Barn Rules**

- **ENTERING THE BUILDING**

You are to enter your horses thru the west sliding door ONLY and proceed directly to the indoor arena. Please tack your horse at your trailer. If weather does not permit this, please use tie areas in the arena to tack. DO NOT USE ANY TIE AREAS IN THE AISLES OR IN THE FRONT AREA OF THE BARN – THESE ARE FOR HOSPITAL USE ONLY.

- **SIGNING IN/OUT AND PAYING**

You MUST sign in/out (name and time entering/exiting the arena) and put payment in the cash box each time you ride at EVH. THERE ARE ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS RULE. **IF YOU CONSISTENTLY DO NOT SIGN IN AND PAY, YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO USE EVH FACILITIES.**

- **ABSOLUTELY NO RUNNING OR YELLING IS ALLOWED IN THE BARN**

There are no exceptions to this rule. This is a hospital with potential ill horses, mares waiting to foal and new foals. PLEASE MONITOR YOUR CHILDREN

- **HELMETS**

Any rider under the age of 18 must wear a riding helmet at all times. NO EXCEPTIONS.

- **OFF LIMITS AREAS**

All Aisleways, Feed room, Medicine Room, Labs, Foaling Area

- **FOOD AND DRINKS**

You must bring your own food and drinks. Any food or drink items in the lounge belong to EVH staff and are not to be consumed by anyone except staff members.

- **MANURE CLEAN UP**

All manure piles made by your horse in the parking lot must be cleaned up before you leave the property. A muck bucket and pitch fork can be found near the west entrance.

- **EQUIPMENT**

Anyone is welcome to use any EVH equipment – i.e. barrels, poles, cones, jumps, etc. Anything you use must be put away before you leave. If something doesn't work or gets broken while in use, please let us know.
